

Year 2 Curriculum Summary for Parents and Carers - Autumn Term 1 2025

<u>English</u>	<u>Maths</u>	<u>History / Geography</u>
<u>Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling</u> We will be learning how to use capital letters, full stops, commas, exclamation marks and question marks correctly in sentences. We will be looking at different spelling rules weekly and learning common exception words. <u>Reading and Comprehension</u> Developing fluency - skills and strategies. Learning to use prediction, sequencing and inference. <u>Writing composition</u> including drafting, editing Learning to improve handwriting and presentation skills. Identifying the features of fiction texts, letter writing and persuasive language, using these in our writing. We will be learning from a range of texts including 'The Day the Crayons Quit' by Drew Dawalt.	<u>Number and place value</u> We will be learning to recognise the value of each digit in a 2-digit number. We will read and write numbers to 100 in numbers and words and count forwards and back in steps of 2,3,5 <u>Addition and Subtraction</u> We will learn to solve problems with addition and subtraction: To recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently, and derive and use related facts up to 100 To show that addition of two numbers can be done in any order (commutative) and subtraction of one number from another cannot.	This half term our focus will be History and we will be learning: 'Why were castles so important to the Normans?' Who were 'The Normans'? To know what castles look like and when most castles in Britain were built. To know that castles had two main purposes (home and protection). To know the main features of a castle. To consider the role of castles for defence. To understand the role of castles as homes. To consider what the lives of people who lived in a castle were like and how this compares to our lives today. To know that some castles are ruins and why.
