

KS2 – Pencil Cases in Yr 3, 4, 5 & 6

Key Stage Two children may bring their own stationery and pencil cases to school. Please see below for a list of items we would like children to have on a day to day basis.

- 2 x writing pencils (HB)
- A small sharpener
- Either a 15cm/30cm ruler
- 2x black handwriting pens (not biro)
- A rubber
- A pack of colouring pencils
- A glue stick (this is particularly useful to have – speeding up many an activity in the classroom)
- 2x wipe clean whiteboard pens
- 2 x purple gel or biro pens
- 1 x yellow highlighter
- 1 x orange highlighter
- A pencil case that comfortably fits into a class tray (internal tray dimensions: 33cm x 25cm x 6cm). Please take into account that some exercise books and reading books go into trays. As well as this, overfilled pencil cases with many different types of ‘smiggle’ rubbers are distracting to the children – please leave these items for use at home.

This list is not compulsory, but we understand that as your child gets older, the importance so many place on owning their own pencil case with their own supplies. We know the children enjoy this and we believe it also promotes independence and taking pride in carrying equipment. Please note that this is KS2 specific; KS1 children are not permitted to bring their own pencil case.
