# Things the children need to bring

- Sleeping Bag
- Pillow
- Waterproof coat
- Sun hat/cap/sun glasses
- Trainers/ comfortable shoes 2 if possible(last year some got soaked in the rain)
- Old trainers which can get dirty (needed for challenge course/beach)
- Slippers (optional but preferable)
- Swim Suit
- Flip flops (if desired for pool session/beach)
- Socks (approx 8 pairs)
- Trousers/ jeans/ track suit bottoms/ shorts/shirts
- Underwear (approx 8 pairs)
- Sweatshirts/Long or short sleeve t-shirts/Jumpers/
- Pyjamas
- Dressing gown (optional)
- Towel
- Toiletries (shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrush, shower gel, flannel, hairbrushes, hair bands, small packet of tissues)
- Sun cream- minimum of factor 30 and one that only needs one application first thing in the morning
- A book, magazines, teddy, watch
- A few plastic bags for dirty clothes etc
- All items in a bag or small suitcase clearly labelled
- £30 spending money (max) to be spent across ice cream shop, PGL shop, Zoo and Cavern gift shops.

# Entertainment for the journey

The children will be allowed to bring a few items for the journey. These should be placed in a small rucksack which is **clearly labelled with their name**.

Things to include:

- Water bottle
- Packed lunch to eat during scheduled stop on journey (no fizzy drinks)
- Travel games
- Books/magazines/comics
- Small notepad and pencil/pen
- A disposable camera/digital (be aware of sand)

These will be the **children's** responsibility to look after.

# Things children DO NOT bring

- Mobile Phones / laptops / Ipads / Smart Watches
- Food and drinks
- Jewellery (stud earrings are allowed)
- Hair dryers
- Medicines (including throat sweets)

# Accommodation

- Boys and girls will sleep in small rooms of 4-8. Teachers sleep in separate bedrooms along the same corridors.
- Each room has an ensuite bathroom which has a toilet and shower.
- In addition to our own staff PGL staff are on site day and night.

# Food

- All food is nut free
- Vegetarians and other dietary needs are catered for
- All children will have three meals a day with lunch times being a packed lunch
- Fresh fruit and vegetables are provided every day at lunch and dinner
- There are water fountains where the children can fill up their water bottles

# Tidy dorm competition

- Children are responsible for keeping their rooms tidy and making their own beds
- There will be a dorm inspection daily and the children will not know when this is going to be!
- They will be scored out of 10; these marks will then be totalled at the end of our stay giving a mark out of 50
- Judges can be bribed/influenced!
- The winners will have an extra playtime plus a Devonshire cream tea served by Marshgate staff!

# Ongoing competition

- To encourage co-operation and good behaviour

# First Aid

- Mrs Freedman is the named First Aider
- Any child that requires travel sickness tablets **should take them before they come to school on Monday**
- Those who need them to travel back (or during our stay) should put them into a small bag with clear instructions and signed permission which will be held by Mrs Freedman. Any child who needs an inhaler or epi-pen which is already in school we will take it with us
- **All medication needs to have written instructions and signed permission from a parent/carer**
- If there are any other medical requirements please speak to Mrs Freedman or your child's class teacher before you leave today.
